 - Moses, The Exodus, Sinai, Wilderness
- IV. Period of Conquest and Settlement in Canaan (Joshua, Judges, Ruth)
 - 1400-1100 BC
 - Joshua, Judges, Samuel
- V. Period of Hebrew Kingdom (1-2 Samuel, 1-2 Kings, 1-2 Chronicles, some prophetic books)
 - 1100-587 BC
 - United Kingdom Saul, David, Solomon
 - Divided Kingdom
 - Northern Kingdom (Falls to Assyria in 722 BC)
 - Southern Kingdom (Falls to Babylon in 587 BC)
- VI. Period of Captivity and Return (Ezra, Nehemiah, some prophetic books)
 - 587 400 BC
 - Three stages of the Babylonian Exile
 - 1. 606-605: Small group (Daniel)
 - 2. 597: Larger group of leaders (Ezekiel)
 - 3. 586: City of Jerusalem falls to Babylonians
 - Three stages of return (due to Persian conquering of Babylon)
 - 1. 539-536: Zerubbabel; temple rebuilt
 - 2. 458: Ezra
 - 3. 444: Nehemiah; walls rebuilt

VII. Inter-Biblical Period

- 400-4 BC
- 538-332 Persian rule -> 332-167 Greek rule -> 167-643 Jewish rule -> 63+ Roman rule

VIII. New Testament Period (All the books of the NT)

- 4 BC AD 90
- Augustus: 27 BC AD 14; Tiberius: AD 14-37; Gaius Caligula: AD 37-41; Claudius: AD 41-54; Nero: AD 54-68; Galba, Otho, Vitellius: AD 68-69; Vespasian: AD 69-79; Titus: AD 79-81; Domitian: AD 81-96
