

SLBC Kids COVID Procedures

Statement of Risk:

- Please understand that while the church is taking steps to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 transmission, there is no risk-free environment. By leaving your child in our care, you acknowledge you are willing to accept responsibility for the risk inherent in gathering.

Sanitation and Safety:

- We observe sanitation procedures appropriate for the age level of each classroom, including routines for snack time, playtime, and diapering.
- Our teachers are getting creative! Activities are being planned with social distancing and separate supplies and toys in mind.
- All of our teachers have undergone safety and hygiene training as well as background checks.
- Teachers and students in Grades 1-6 will be required to wear masks.

Check/In:

- All families of preschoolers need to check in and get labels. Staff will be at the desk to type phone numbers into kiosks. Labels will print from carts parked 6ft in front of the desks for families to access from a safe distance.
- Adults and grade school children will need to wear masks during check in and drop off.
- Families should complete Family Health Screening Checklist before arriving on Sunday morning.
- Only one parent should walk into the children's hallways to drop children off at their classrooms. Parents must wear masks when dropping off their children.
- Children will not be allowed to bring any items into their classrooms.
- Parents and siblings will not be allowed to enter the classrooms to drop off

Parents of Infants:

- Please do not bring strollers or car seats into the building.
- All personal items should be well labeled and contained in one diaper bag.
- If you would like us to feed your child a bottle or snacks, please provide these items in your diaper bag.

Parents of Twos & Threes:

- Please do not bring strollers or car seats into the building.
- All personal items should be well labeled and contained in one diaper bag.

- Your child will be offered an individually wrapped snack (goldfish, cheese-its, vanilla wafers, or animal crackers) and a cup of water. Everyone will wash hands before and after snack time.

Pre-K and Kindergarten Parents:

- Your child will be offered an individually wrapped snack (goldfish, cheese-its, vanilla wafers, or animal crackers) and a cup of water. Everyone will wash hands before and after snack time

Handling Illness:

- Please complete the Family Health Screening Checklist before you enter the building on Sunday. If your child or anyone in your household has been diagnosed with COVID19, have COVID19 symptoms, or is sick, please stay home.
- We ask that parents notify us if a child has become sick after being in our care, so that we may notify others according to contact tracing protocols.
- If a child becomes sick while in our care, they will be isolated in a separate room until their parents can pick them up.
