Our Program

Our motto is "What goes home in a child's heart is more important than what goes home in their hand." We accomplish this by teaching them first and foremost about how much God loves them and how he made them special. Each week children in our 2's classes through Bridge class attend chapel where they learn to worship God through Bible stories and song.

CDO strives to provide a nurturing environment in which our children develop a curiosity for learning. Each age group has developmentally appropriate curriculum. Our children learn through play in centers, small groups, and circle time. All children attend music and motor skill enrichment classes each week; Pre-K and Bridge classes also attend a literacy enrichment class.

Equally important to our program is helping children grow socially and emotionally. Each class works on skills such as learning to take turns/sharing, developing empathy, following rules and routines, self-control, individual responsibility and much more.





Toddlers (15-23 months) and Two-Year-Old Classes

Our toddler classes utilize a theme based curriculum that focuses on language development, cognitive development, physical development, and social/emotional development. Our two year old classes use Mother Goose Time curriculum which focuses on pre-literacy/pre-math centers (introduction of letters, numbers 1-10, shapes, and colors). Children explore through hands-on manipulatives, imaginative play, and teacher-directed activities. Our toddlers also have a nap time from 12:00pm-1:20pm each day.

3-Year-Old Classes

Our 3 year old classes use Mother Goose Time curriculum focusing on pre-literacy and pre-writing skills, pre-math (introduction 1-20, patterns, sorting, etc.), and science. In this age group, there is an increased focus on intentional instruction in key areas of development so children ages 36-48 months can effectively continue on the path to kindergarten readiness.

Pre-K Classes

Our Pre-K classes implement the Handwriting Without Tears Curriculum which focuses on writing, language and literacy, and numbers and math. Pre-K also uses the Heggerty Phonemic Awareness curriculum to encourage the pre-reading skill/understanding that spoken words are made up of individual sounds. Science lessons focus on the scientific method of hypothesis making and discovery. Our teachers work on developing strong work habits, listening skills, and appropriate classroom behaviors and routines to prepare these children for kindergarten success.

Bridge

Our Bridge class is a transitional program to "bridge the gap" between Pre-K and kindergarten for children who require more time developing socially, developmentally and/or academically. By delaying the enrollment year for kindergarten, these children not only learn essential pre-literacy, pre-math, and other cognitive skills, but also develop social and self-regulation skills needed to succeed in school. While our class uses the kindergarten version of the Handwriting Without Tears curriculum as well as the Heggerty Phonemic Awareness curriculum, our smaller class size and student-teacher ratio offer the time and space to build the foundation skills necessary for our students to adapt successfully to kindergarten when they are ready.
