



CULTURAL

Let the power of public art enhance your experience in Sugar Land.

Sugar Land's growing art scene offers visitors exciting things to see and do throughout the city. Visitors can go to the Sugar Land Art Center & Gallery. where admission into this local artist collective is free. The space operates not only as a gallery, but also as a working artist studio. The Sugar Land Art Center & Gallery also offers adult and children's art classes in a variety of disciplines and has a gift shop. Visitors can also stop by the Sugar Land Heritage Museum & Visitor Center to view a Sugar Land historical timeline and other cultural art-themed exhibits throughout the year. Go on a drive around Sugar Land and discover a handful of creative art sprinkled throughout the city. First up is the Space Cowboys Mural, which was created to commemorate the city's Minor League baseball team located at The Lawn at First Colony Mall (behind Dimassi's). Next up is the Sugar Rush Mural at Sugar Land Town Square, where you are invited to celebrate the sweet history of the city by activating the mural with a QR code and seeing it come to life through your phone. If you want to step into a historical part of the city meet Crush the Alligator at Lonnie Green Park, located in

one of the first neighborhoods


of the former company town. Then, make your way to **Brazos** River Park and visit Interlacing Patterns which poetically interweaves Sugar Land's natural beauty with the cultural heritage of the city. Inspired by Sugar Land's connection to the **Brazos River** and the complex natural ecosystem found along the banks, the beautifully intricate, cellular cross sections of riparian trees and aquatic plants are artistically interpreted to resemble geometric configurations.

As you're exploring Sugar Land Town Square, add this to your last stop and visit Bob Pack's Father of Texas, one of the most iconic bronze statues. The statue depicts Stephen F. Austin crossing the Brazos River in front of the Sugar Land City Hall. His horse rearing, Austin struggles to lead a packhorse stumbling in the river's current, represented by the surrounding fountain waters. You can't miss it during your visit!

Sugar Land is also home to several kinetic sculptures including a sculpture by artist Lyman Whitaker of Whitaker Studio at the entrance of Sugar Land Regional Airport. According to Whitaker, "The twist and flow of this installation, VorTEX, gives the observer a chance to check into the weather before taking flight at Sugar Land Regional Airport. Its job is to connect the viewer to the surrounding natural elements."



For more Sugar Land history, visit slheritage.org. You can tour the Sugar Land Heritage Museum & Visitor Center or take a guided walking tour with a docent from the Heritage Foundation every second Saturday of the month.

Sugar Land's vibrant history is peppered with influences from Native Americans, the Spaniards, Mexicans and American pioneers. In 1821, Stephen F. Austin received a charter to settle 300 American families in Texas. The fertile land of Fort Bend County was included in Austin's charter and eventually set the stage for Sugar Land's rich agricultural heritage.




