OUR PROGRAM

Our motto is “What goes home in a child’s heart is more important than what goes home in their hand.” We accomplish this by teaching them first and foremost about how much God loves them and how He made them special. Each week children in our 3s class through Bridge class attend chapel where they learn to worship God through Bible stories and songs.

CDO strives to provide a nurturing environment in which our children develop a curiosity for learning. Each age group has developmentally appropriate curriculum. Our children learn through play in centers, small groups, and circle time. All children attend music and motor skills enrichment classes each week. Pre-K and Bridge classes also attend a literacy class.

Equally important to our program is helping children grow socially and emotionally. Each class works on skills such as learning to take turns/sharing, developing empathy, following rules and routines, self-control, individual responsibility, and much more.



★ TODDLERS (15-23 MONTHS) AND TWO-YEAR-OLD CLASSES

Our toddler classes utilize a theme based curriculum that focuses on language development, cognitive development, physical development, and social/emotional development. Our two-year-old classes use Mother Goose Time Curriculum which focuses on pre-literacy/pre-math centers (introduction to letters, numbers 1-5, shapes and colors). Children explore through hands-on manipulatives, imagination play, and teacher directed activities. Our toddlers also have a nap time from 12:00pm-1:20pm each day.

★ THREE-YEAR-OLD CLASSES

Our three-year-old classes use Mother Goose Time curriculum focusing on pre-literacy, pre-math, and pre-writing skills (identify letters and sounds, recognize and identify 1-10, concepts of quantity, patterns and sorting), and science. In this age group, there is an increased focus on intentional instruction in key areas of development so children ages 36-48 months can effectively continue on the path to kindergarten readiness.

★ PRE-K CLASSES

Our Pre-K classes use the Heggerty Phonemic Awareness curriculum to encourage pre-reading skills/understanding that spoken words are made up with individual sounds. Pre-K also implements the Handwriting Without Tears curriculum which focuses on writing letters and numbers. Science lessons focus on the scientific method of making hypotheses and discovery. To prepare these children for kindergarten success, the teachers work on developing strong work habits, listening skills, and appropriate classroom behavior and routines.



★ BRIDGE

Our Bridge Class is a transitional program to “bridge the gap” between Pre-K and Kindergarten for children who require more time to develop socially and/or academically. By delaying the kindergarten enrollment a year, these children learn essential pre-literacy, pre-math, and other cognitive skills needed to succeed in school. Our Bridge class uses the kindergarten version of Handwriting Without Tears curriculum, as well as the Heggerty Phonemic Awareness curriculum. Our smaller class size and student-teacher ratio offer the time and space to build the foundational skills necessary for our students to adapt successfully to kindergarten when they are ready.
